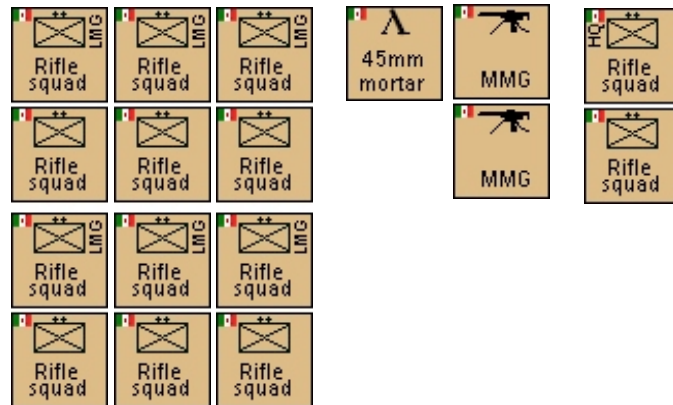


Italian Infantry Company 1938-41

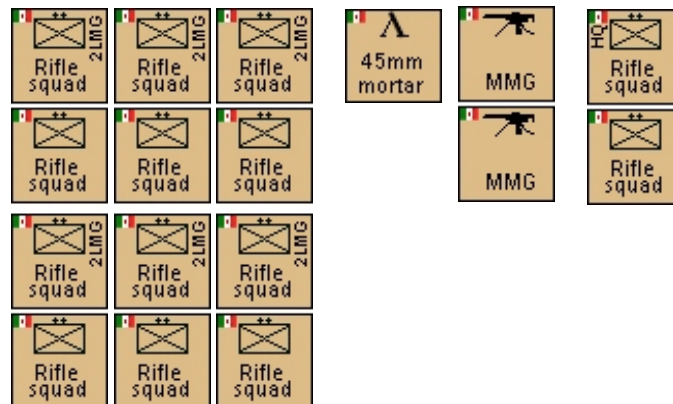
3 platoons of 2 sections each. Each section was equivalent to two rifle squads, one with a LMG. A 45mm mortar team. HQ was a large contingent equivalent to 2 rifle squads.



2 Solothurn AT rifles were issued to each battalion in 1940.

Italian Infantry Company 1942+

3 platoons of 2 sections each. Each section had an assault group with 2 LMGs and one rifle squad. A 45mm mortar team. HQ was a large contingent equivalent to 2 rifle squads.



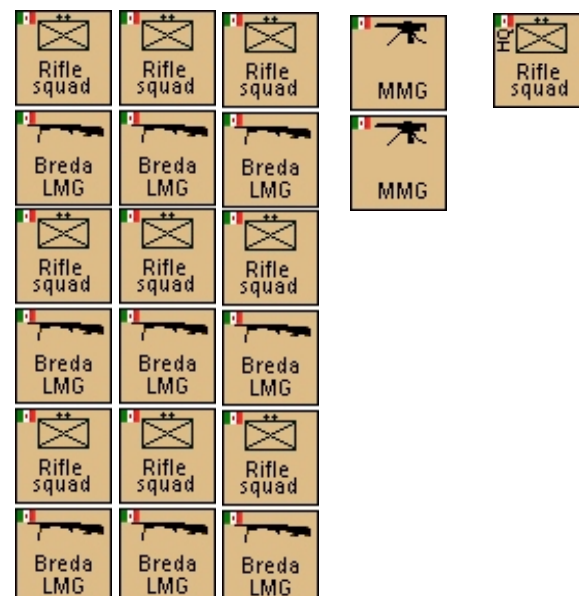
Note-

6 Solothurn AT rifles were issued to each battalion starting 1941.

Captured Polish Wz.35 AT rifles were issued starting Dec 1941 to "Giovani Fascisti" battalions.

Italian Parachute Company

3 platoons of 3 rifle squads. Each squad also was joined with a LMG team. HQ is a rifle squad.



In 1943 the Breda was being replaced by the MG42.

Italian Folgore Company at El Alamein

3 platoons of 3 rifle squads with a LMG each. With each squad was issued a WZ35 anti-tank rifle. HQ is a rifle squad.
